1. Rakhi Celebration with Firefighters 🚒

Students will visit the **Fire Brigade Office** and celebrate **Raksha Bandhan with our brave firefighters**. Children will express their gratitude by tying Rakhis and offering sweets as a gesture of respect and appreciation.

The visit will also include an interactive **fire-safety awareness session**, where students will:

- Learn about the role and responsibilities of firefighters.

2. Educational Visit to the Post Office 📮
